EAR DROP APPLICATION: Best to warm oil slightly by holding the bottle under hot water for a few minutes. Tilt head to one side and apply 2-3 drops into the ear and stay in position for a few minutes, gently massage in a circular motion to allow it to penetrate the ear canal. Repeat step in the other ear (even if the other ear is not infected). Repeat 2 - 3 times a day until it improves.

TOPICAL APPLICATION: Applied topically for treatment of skin infections, wounds, and inflammation. Apply a few drops to the affected area. Massage gently and cover the area with a clean cloth or bandage. Repeat this 2 - 3 times a day until improvement.

PRECAUTIONS: Based on limited research during pregnancy and nursing, it is best to avoid during pregnancy and nursing. If you have underlying medical conditions or are on medications, it is best to consult with your healthcare provider before using. Before using, test a small area on your skin to check for allergic reactions. This ear oil may interact with certain medications, including blood thinners or high blood pressure medications.

Do NOT use if eardrum is ruptured or perforated.

POTENTIAL SIDE EFFECTS:

While this ear oil is generally considered safe, some people may experience side effects, which include: Skin Irritations, allergic reactions and upset stomach.

CANINE & FELINE USE & APPLICATION:

Symptoms of Pet ear Infection includes: Shaking of head and scratches ears, dark discharge, strong odor, excessive wax build-up, sensitivity to the touch of ears. Apply a few drops in each ear 1 - 2 times daily until it improves.
Gently massage the ears in a circular motion.

Do NOT use if eardrum is ruptured or perforated.
